Devotion:

Text: For He Himself has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." Heb 13:5b (NKJV)

JESUS NEVER FAILS! "Never" is a big word. What a comforting thought that our Savior will never leave us. He will never forsake us. No one but our loving Lord Jesus can make such a promise. We may have struggles. We may fail Him sometimes. Circumstances and other people may have let us down many times. Even family members can fall short of our expectations.
